Rules:

St Endellion Parish Council reserves the right to remove, without notice any memorial, which they deem objectionable or of unauthorised type or size, or items which are damaged or broken.

Children under the age of 12, attending the cemetery, must be accompanied by an adult.

Animal remains, including ashes are not permitted to be interred within the cemetery.

Items left in the cemetery are done so at the owners risk. St Endellion Parish Council does not accept liability for individual items, including any removed for storage within the cemetery.
